## Explanation of Retinal Screening Photography Fees

We are committed to offering our patients the most thorough eye health examination available. The most important part of your eye examination is the evaluation of your eye health which relates to your body's overall health. Our doctor is trained to look for the earliest signs of conditions like glaucoma, macular degeneration, diabetes, hypertension, cancers and many more health and eye conditions.

Due to advances in technology, methods used to observe and evaluate your eyes have improved dramatically. Optomap® or widefield digital scanning ophthalmoscopy has become the new standard of care for evaluating the internal parts of the human eye.

## Explanation of Contact Lens Prescribing Fees

The evaluation or re-evaluation process for contact lens wear includes

- ✓ Measurements necessary to assure the eyes are healthy enough to wear contact lenses
- ✓ Discussion and explanation of the best contact for your unique eyes
- ✓ Follow-up care related to the fit of your contact lenses for one year

The fee for contact lens prescribing ranges from \$105-225 and is decided by the doctor based upon the complexity of your prescription and the condition of your eyes. This is in addition to any fee from an eye health exam and is due at the time of the contact lens evaluation or re-evaluation. This fee may not be covered by insurance.

In Indiana, contact lens prescriptions are valid for one year. If you wish to continue wearing contacts after the one-year period, you will need to have a new contact lens evaluation. Please ask a staff member if you have any questions.
